- the headteacher effectively drives the educational performance of the school
- the school's financial resources are used efficiently



We meet at the school once every half term on a Thursday evening for full board meetings and each governor sits on at least one sub-committee (to suit skills and experience) which also meet at least once a term. We generally meet 5.00pm-7.00pm (but Resources Committee generally meets 1.30pm-3.00pm) and governors do make monitoring visits to the school during school hours.

To be a school governor you do not need a background in education – we value a diverse range of skills and interests.

We offer training to develop and enhance your skills, and you will be part of a supportive and pro-active team of volunteers working to deliver the best possible education for children in our community.

The role of school governor is subject to a DBS check.
