In 2020/21 the government provided additional funding for Catch-Up Premium and funding for tutorial programmes. The Catch-Up premium was £80 per pupil for all pupils, particularly disadvantaged, SEND and vulnerable pupils to receive the catch-up support needed to make substantial progress by the end of the academic year. There is an expectation that all pupils receive a high-quality education, and our curriculum remains broad and ambitious. When needed, remote education was high quality and safe and aligned as closely as possible with in-school provision. There was prioritisation within subjects of the most important components for progression. The curriculum planning was informed by an assessment of pupils' starting points and the need to address their learning gaps, we made use of regular formative assessment with a coherent plan to return to a normal curriculum by the end of summer 2021.
