Maths: We will be learning to count, use mathematical words and recognise numbers to 10. We shall count the whole number, count groups of objects that add up to the number and share the number into groups. We will be noticing how a quantity of objects is made up from other quantities, eg within 3 objects there are 2 and 1 objects or 1, 1 and 1 object.

Maybe you could practise counting at home. You could count the whole number or see how many different ways you can make that number.


